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The Fresh Start programme is an individualised, flexible online programme which will assist people aged 19-24 years to re-engage with education.

Where:

The programme is studied online in a flexible manner to fit around your other commitments. Access to a computer and the internet is essential to complete this course but you can use equipment in the College's Learning Resource Centres if you don't have computer or internet access at home.

When:

The course starts in September 2020 with enrolments accepted throughout the year. The programme duration can vary between 10 weeks and a full academic year depending upon the number of hours that you study each week.

Course content:

Level 1 Certificate Mandatory unit:

- Understanding how to be successful

You can then choose four further units from the following:

- Health and safety in the workplace
- Job seeking skills
- Equality and diversity at work
- Employment skills
- Employment rights, contracts and pay
- Customer service skills
- Understanding pensions
- Introduction to catering and hospitality
- Introduction to construction and building
- Introduction to transport and logistics
